Dinamica Generale is directing its policy towards sustainability and against violence, human rights violations and environmental degradation in the extraction and marketing of some minerals (**gold, tin, tantalum and tungsten**) coming from the geographical area defined " **Conflict Region** ". This region includes the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and neighboring countries.

The "Securities and Exchange Commission" (SEC) prepared regulations "Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act", section #1502 concerning requirements of detection and publication relating to the "Conflict Minerals".

For this reason **Dinamica Generale** is committed to introduce in its products **3TG** metals "**Conflict free**" requiring its suppliers to undertake a proper evaluation process of their supply chains in order to ensure that the specified metals come from only:

- mines and smelters outside the "Conflict Region"
- mines and smelters that have been certified by an independent third party as "Conflict Free", if located within the "Conflict Region".

Our aim is to ensure that into our products there are only materials and components "Conflict Free".
